

# Adopt a Museum Pass

**The Family Friends of the Billerica Public Library, Inc.** is a non-profit advocacy and support organization for the Library. Each year the Friends raise money to support programs and services at the library which would otherwise not be possible through our municipal operating budget. One of the most popular programs which the Friends fund is the Museum Pass program. Through this program, museum memberships are purchased by the Friends and are made available to Billerica residents and Family Friends members to use to obtain free or discounted admission to these venues.

The Library currently has passes to 13 area museums and attractions whose annual cost is nearly \$5,000.
